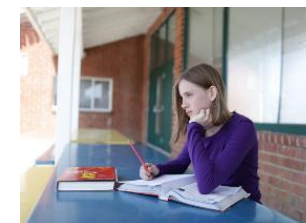
Here in Chester you may know us as the folks that bring you the Christmas Parade and the Concert on the Green but we also support:
