The old head screwed off fairly easily and out fell a piece of plastic with itty-bitty holes in it. It took us a few minutes to realize it was a water saver . . . doing exactly what it was supposed to do.

The Club is the same way in some respects. Take the Spring Volksmarsch for example. We allowed ourselves to become upset because it barely broke even. 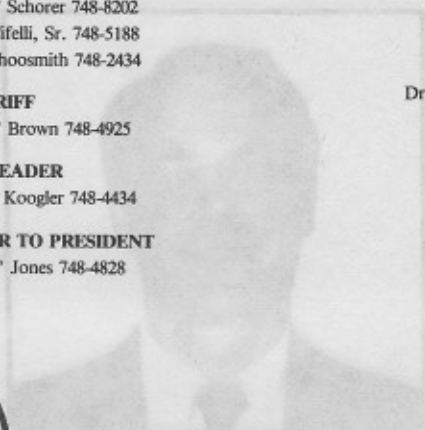
