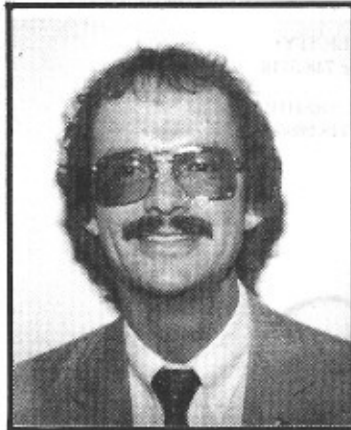

- Attend a district convention or conference or a planned divisional meeting or conference

In certain of the above instances (our secretary has the complete "Official Attendance Rules") the makeup can occur 6 days before or 6 days after the month in which the meeting was missed. A maximum of two credits per month applies to meetings of Circle K and Key Clubs and one per month to participation in club projects.
