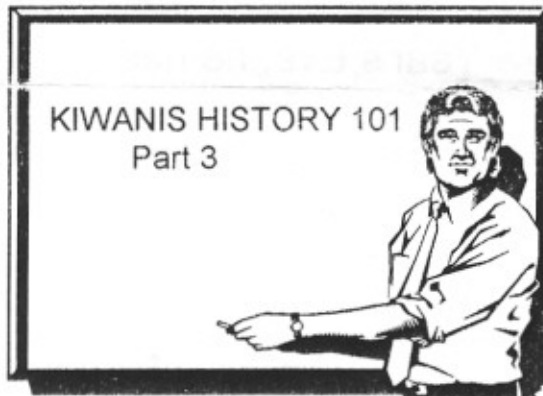

Prior to the Birmingham Convention in 1919, the organization of all Kiwanis clubs was controlled by a professional organizer, Allen Simpson Browne, who retained a specific amount of the membership fee of every new member.

The second Kiwanis Club was organized on October 19, 1915, in Cleveland, Ohio. It had 135 applicants for membership at the time.

DIRECTIONS TO CHRISTMAS PARTY

Take I-95N to the Downtown Expressway. On the Downtown Expressway take the 1st exit (canal Street). There will be a fifteen cent toll. At 10th Street take a left, cross Byrd and follow 10th behind the Twin Towers on the right. Go into the second towers parking garage. Take the elevator to the lobby. Get off the elevator and go to the second set of elevators to get to the Downtown Club. You can get your parking ticket validated at the Downtown Club.
