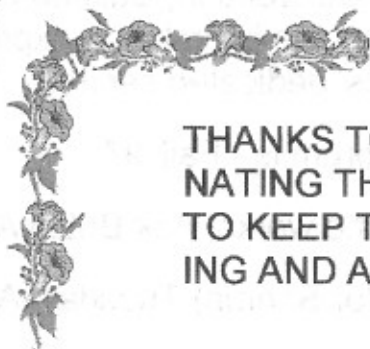

notice to take the structure down by Jul 16 or go to court!

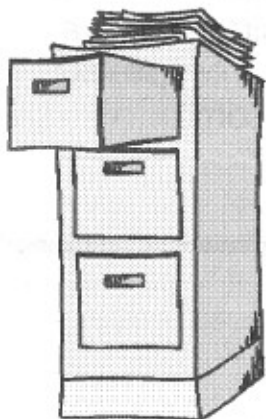
