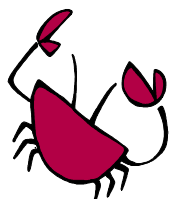
### WEST POINT GOLF TOURNAMENT

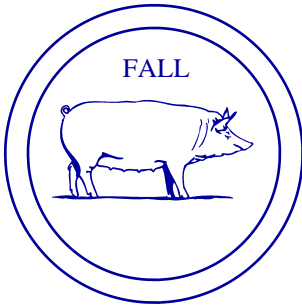
